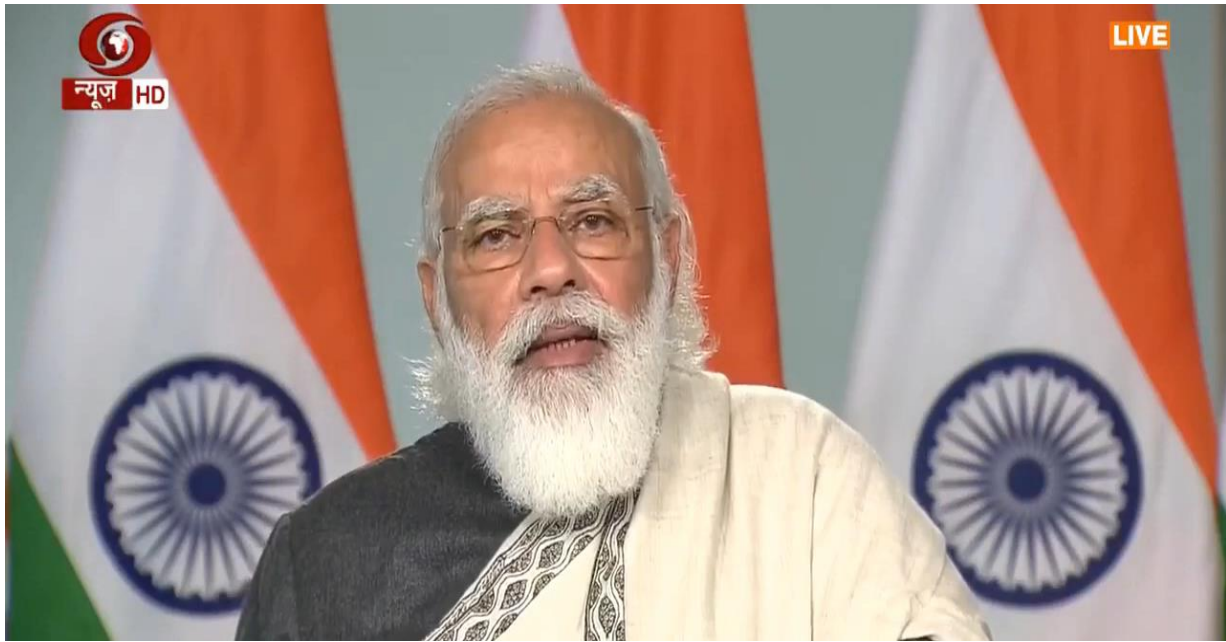



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About NeVA

“Digital India” Programme introduced by the Government of India aims to transform the entire ecosystem of public services through the use of Information Technology. It focuses on three core areas: digital infrastructure a utility to every citizen, digital empowerment of citizens, governance and services on demand. Digital Legislature is defined as the use of ICTs in legislative institutions across the country, whether in Union/State with the objective of enhancing and strengthening their core functions and operations. It helps in promoting e-Democracy and encourages participation of citizens in the democratic and socio-economic platforms. It helps in strengthening the interaction between the members of Legislative Houses (Parliament or Legislative Houses) and the general citizens. Besides this, it also facilitates efficient public service delivery, enhances social inclusion, allows transparency in the public service, and facilitates cost savings in government’s bid to involve citizens in its governing processes. Digital Legislatures for Members consists of Digital House, Member’s Portal, Mobile/Tablet apps (iOS, Android).

National e-Vidhan Application (NeVA) is one of the 44 Mission Mode Projects (MMPs) with the approval of Cabinet. Apex Committee in its 3rd meeting held on 15th October, 2015 decided to make the Ministry of Parliamentary Affairs (MPA) as Nodal Ministry for implementation of e-Vidhan & e-Sansad MMP and empowered it to take all necessary steps to promote & roll out e-Vidhan/e-Sansad which has been now re-designated as National e-Vidhan Application (NeVA) in all the 37 States/UT Legislatures and the 2 Houses of Parliament viz. Lok Sabha & Rajya Sabha supported by National Informatics Centre (NIC). Apex Committee on Digital India in its 4th meeting held on 16th June 2016 decided that the funding for e-Vidhan would be provided by the Ministry of Parliamentary Affairs (MPA) and technical support by Ministry of Electronics and Information Technology (MeitY). Subsequently, NeVA MMP with total outlay of Rs.673.94 Crore was approved by Public Investment Board (PIB) on 15th January, 2020 and Minister of Parliamentary Affairs also approved the same on 27th January, 2020. NeVA MMP has been approved by Finance Minister on 5th February, 2020. Ministry of Finance in PIB meeting for NeVA project approval, have recommended to make provisions in NeVA Software for the use by the two Houses of Parliament with minimal modifications and to avoid reinventing the wheel again with respect of software development.

The Notification, Guidelines and MoU of the scheme are available on the website of NeVA (<https://www.neva.gov.in>) as well as the Ministry of Parliamentary Affairs (<https://www.mpa.gov.in>).

Bringing this electronic platform results in huge savings on paper (App. 340 Cr. annually), thereby leading to reduction of Carbon Footprints and moving a step forward in the achievement of United Nation Development Programme’s Sustainable Development Goal (SDG) -15 “Life on Earth”.

Features of NeVA

- NeVA has been developed to function as a member centric application, device neutral and user-friendly application to equip all the members to handle diverse House Business elegantly by putting entire information needed by them in their hand held devices/ tablets and equip all the branches of legislatures/ departments to handle it efficiently and creating an efficient inclusive database thereby overhauling the way our legislatures work with facilities for live webcasting.
- NeVA is a generic digital application hosted on National Cloud - Meghraj with maintenance, security and disaster recovery for all legislatures.
- NeVA-Mobile App facilitates Ministers/Members to get the entire House Business including replies to questions and papers to be laid in the House, at a specified time before the beginning of the daily proceedings whereas Hon'ble Speaker gets the entire House Business as and when available according to the Rules of Procedure and Conduct of Business of Houses.
- Inside the House, NeVA Digital House Module supports a digital e-Book format accessible through member's login on touch-screen device installed at Member's Desks. Digital House Module enables E-voting and E-Attendance along with running the House digitally.
- NeVA provides all relevant information like Notices, Bulletins which is issued by legislatures from time to time for information of all members and other stakeholders. Accessibility to contact details, Rules of Procedure, List of Business, Starred/Unstarred Questions and Answers, text of Bills for introduction, consideration and passing, text of all papers laid, Committee Report, Proceedings of the House, synopsis of proceedings, provisional calendar and rotation of Ministries, News and press releases and reference materials along with the information relating to composition of all Committees including details of Committee meetings, their agendas, information relating to personal claims of Members like Salary and Allowances etc. is provided through NeVA. Live webcasting/TV facility is also available on this application.
- NeVA also helps the presiding officers in the management of the House via House Management Applications and e-Book. Hon'ble Ministers, who have to reply to the House, can seek supplementary replies on their mobiles/e-Book from the Administrative Secretaries.

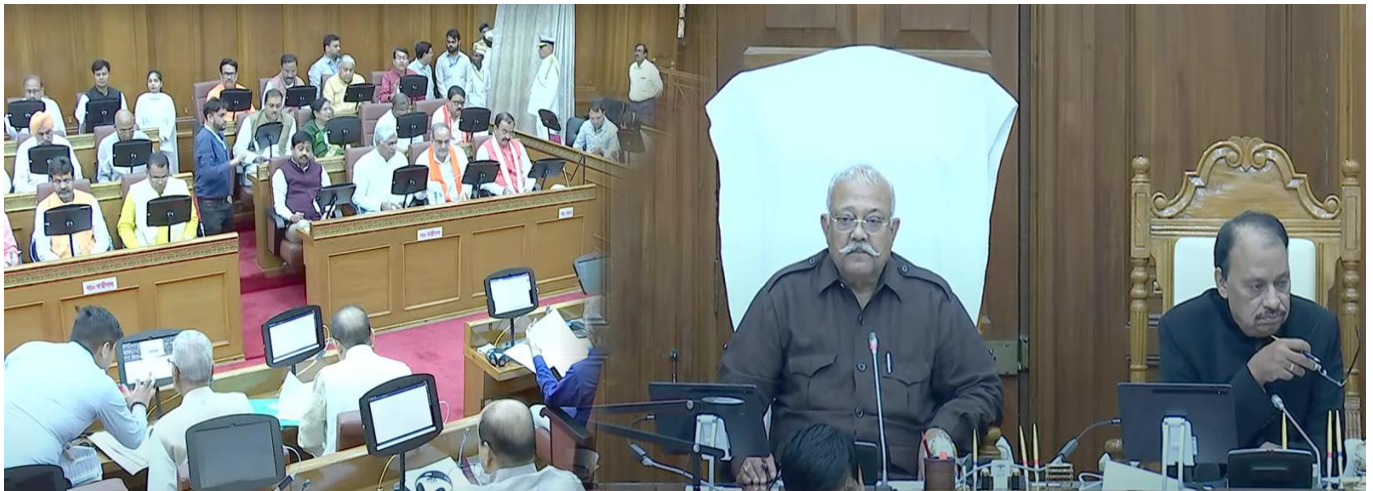
